- The Top 2 from each division will bowl a 2 Game Final with the Stage 3 highest total pinfall from the 2 games being the winner (Pinfall not carried from previous stage)

**Tournament Conditions:** This is a Scratch/Handicap event open to all 2023 TBA Registered Junior Bowlers (Must have been 17 years of age or younger on the 1st of Jan 2023) Entry will open on or after Wednesday the 1st of March via tenpin results website and entries will close when squads are full or on the 1st of April (late entries can be accepted at the discretion of the Tournament Director). Re-Entry not available. All Games will be bowled in accordance with TBA Rules and Regulations. TBA Cards must be available at the time of check-in, or your 2023 registration must be viewable on TBA's website with the correct spelling of your name. Female Scratch Bowlers will receive 8 Pins per game in all stages. For Restricted Bowers Handicap will be 100% of a base that complies with TBA regulations (higher than the highest Average) You must select if you are bowling restricted or Scratch at entry and this cannot be changed. Averages will be taken from Tenpin Results with your highest league average as at the 1st of March (min 24 games must have been bowled to establish this average) If you have a protest of your average this must be emailed to anna@mackayleisurecentre.com.au prior to the 25th of March. Dress Code: Neat tidy acceptable bowling attire is required. NO DENIM, SINGLETS OR YOGA PANTS ALLOWED. Any late check-ins for any stage will be disqualified and replaced by the next available reserve. Any matters not covered in these conditions will be decided by the tournament director whose decision will be final. In the event of a tie for any position the place will be awarded to the bowler who bowled the highest game in that same stage. If the highest game is the same the next highest will be the deciding game and so on.

Pinfall is dropped after each stage. Registration is via tenpinresults.com.au. If you have problems logging onto this site, please contact Tenpin Bowling Australia (or if you have a friend/relative who has a tenpin results log on they can register for you) Your spot is not reserved until full payment has been paid. 1st prize is locked in, all other prizes are variable based on numbers. Prize fund advertised is based on 36 Bowlers. No refunds of entry unless the Tournament is cancelled. Refund of Entry Fees — Should a refund of a player's entry fee be required because of an event cancellation or approved refund by the tournament director, the full amount paid will be transferred to the player's portal as a credit amount. The player then has two options 1. Use the total credit amount for any other tournament that is using online entries 2. Request a Cash-out of the total credit amount less the processing fee. (3%)
