Nominations are open for juniors to represent Tenpin Bowling Association of Townsville Inc. at the 2023 NQJC Allan Russell Intercity Shield to be held at Mackay Leisure Centre, 95 Broadsound Road, Paget, Qld, 4740 on Saturday 16th September 2023, Sunday 17th September 2023 and Monday 18th September 2023. Four teams are required Boy and Girl Scratch, Boy and Girl Handicap. We require 6 bowlers for each team. (Total 24 Bowlers)

Eligibility: Open to all persons who have not obtained the age of 18 years as of 1/1/2023 who have paid their initial 2023 TBA membership with Tenpin Bowling Association of Townsville Inc. and who meet the eligibility criteria on page 2.

Selection is conditional on all bowlers having bowled All Events at the Townsville Championships in 2022. Any bowler who cannot meet the relevant criteria (2022 championships) must apply for an exemption to be eligible to roll-off, this includes exemptions for those who did not compete, must be received by the secretary by 14th April 2023.

ROLL-OFF: Teams will be selected by a Roll-off and selection, to be held on Sunday 23rd April 2023. Check-in closes at 9.45am bowl at 10.00 am. A Roll-Off will include six (6) games bowled on Sunday 23rd April 2023. Handicap for Male and Female Handicap Teams to be used is 100% of 300. Averages to be used for the roll-off will be the highest league average obtained over at least 24 games, as at 31st March 2023. The top four (4) bowlers in each division will be automatically in the team with a further two (2) for each team selected by the Selection Panel.

Closing Date: **Nominations close Friday 14th April 2023 at 6.00 P.M.**

COST OF ROLL-OFF: Cost of Roll-offs is \$50.00 payable at the time of nomination. Should a refund of a player's entry fee be required because of an event cancellation or approved refund by the tournament director, the full amount paid will be transferred to the player's portal as a credit amount. The player then has two options:
a. Use the total credit amount for any other tournament that is using online entries,
b. Request a Cash-out of the total credit amount less the processing fee. (3%)

SELECTION CRITERIA

Rules governing Junior Intercity Annual Tournament as per TBAT By.Laws

- a) All bowlers nominating must have paid their initial Registration with the T.B.A.T. for the current year.
- b) All bowlers must bowl All Events in the Townsville Championships of the current year.
- c) All bowlers must bowl All Events in the NQJC Champions of the current year.
- d) Must be bowling consistently on a regular basis in a league in a weekly competition.
- e) A junior is defined as a bowler who has not reached the age of 18 on 1st January of the current year.
- f) Must have bowled at least the last six months prior to the closing date of nominations in a league at Townsville Tenpin & Fun Centre.
- g) Averages for championships and Intercity as advised by the N.Q.J.C. after their annual meetings.
- h) Exemptions from the above must be in writing and submitted with the nomination to the Association prior to the closing date of the nominations.

All Bowlers that have been sanctioned in 2022 must have bowled All Events in the Townsville Championships of 2022. All new Juniors must bowl Townsville Championships of 2023.

All TBA rules and regulations apply.

A brief resume is required to be supplied with all nominations for selection purposes. Any bowlers not submitting a resume will be ineligible for selection process. Resumes to be forwarded to tsv.secretary@nqtenpin.com.au no later than Friday 14th April 2023 at 6.00 pm.

No late nominations will be accepted.

Roll-off Exemptions. Requests for Exemptions:

It is preferable all nominees attend the roll off. However, any bowler seeking to be exempted from participating in the 6 games roll off needs to submit a written request for exemption to The Secretary of Tenpin Bowling Association of Townsville Inc. no later than **6.00 pm Friday 14th April 2023**, with the exception of emergency medical or personal exemptions. Any application for an exemption must be accompanied by a brief resume and a detailed reason as to why the exemption is being requested, along with verifiable confirmation (i.e. a medical certificate, letter from employer, etc.). All requests will be verified by The Tournament Committee who will forward any exemptions to the TBAT Executive who will have the final say.

Should the request for an exemption be granted, the applicable bowler will be included in the bowlers considered for selection. However, an exemption is not an assurance of your selection in the team. **Regardless of Written exemption. Payments MUST still be paid and Registered on Tenpinresults.com.au**



TIES: If a tie should occur for the 4th placing the highest last game score will be used to break the tie.

Accommodation in Mackay is the responsibility of individual bowlers.

If selected into the team, acceptance and initial payment of \$100.00 is required within 7 days of selection to secure your position in the team.

Team Meetings and Trainings: **A Minimum of 2 Team Trainings are to be held and will be compulsory. Training 1 May 28th 2023 10am to 12pm. Training 2 16th July 2023 10am to 12pm. And due to the availability (or lack thereof) in Mackay on that weekend, Accomodation may be booked independently, But a Compulsory TBAT Team Dinner will be Held on the Saturday night in Mackay, following the completion of the days play.**
