ENTRY REGISTRATION

All entries will be accepted and processed via TenpinResults. Entries will close 22 September 2023. Late entries will be accepted at the discreation of the Tournament Director.

A \$100 deposit will be required at time of entering with the balance payable by the 1 September 2023.

ENTRY FEE

The entry fee for participation in both the TBA18 and TBA21 Cup's is \$240. The TBA21 and TBA18 Cup's will be run together. Athletes are limited to competing in one event and must nominate choice at the time of entering.

NATIONALLY RANKED EVENT

The TBA18 Cup will be a nationally ranked event within the TBA National Junior Rankings. The TBA21 Cup will be a nationally ranked event within the TBA National Youth Rankings.

OFFICIAL PRACTICE

Athletes will be able to book official practice sessions through TenpinResults for a price of \$15 for a 1 hour session.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT SUMMARY

QUALIFYING

SATURDAY 23 SEPTEMBER

- All bowlers will complete nine (9) games of qualifying in three (3) blocks of three (3) games with athletes changing lanes each three (3) game block.
- TBA18 At the conclusion of the qualifying squads, the top twelve (12) male bowlers and top twelve (12) female bowlers will advance to Stage 2.
- TBA21- At the conclusion of the qualifying squads, the top eight (8) male bowlers and top eight (8) female bowlers will advance directly to the finals. Finishing positions will determine the seedings for the finals series bracket.

STAGE 2 - TBA18

SUNDAY 24 SEPTEMBER

- Check-in by 8:00 am to commence bowling at 8:15 am
- The Top 12 male bowlers and Top 12 female bowlers will play a further four (4) games with pinfall to carry forward and athletes changing lanes each game
- The Top eight (8) male bowlers and Top eight (8) female bowlers by total pinfall from qualifying and stage 2 will advance to the Finals. Finishing positions will determine the seedings for the finals series bracket.
- Tie broken by 9th & 10th frame playoff, if still tied, then sudden death (single frame)




TOURNAMENT FORMAT SUMMARY

FINALS BRACKET SERIES

SUNDAY 24 SEPTEMBER

- Athletes must check-in by 10:00 am or reserves will be called.
- The format of the finals bracket series is a single game, double elimination bracket format
- E.g. Once a finalist loses two games, they are eliminated from the tournament
- The draw of the finals bracket can be found in the illustration below.
- Four brackets will be in play TBA18 Females, TBA18 Males, TBA21 Females, & TBA21 Males
- Victors of Match 14 within each bracket shall earn the esteemed title of champions for their respective cup event unless the defeated contender encounters their first loss in the bracket. In such an instance, a repechage will be initiated, prompting a rematch where the ultimate victor claims the national title.





> ALL-STAR BONUS ROUND

- At the conclusion of the bracket finals, an All-Star bonus round will take place
- The Top 3 TBA21 males will play the Top 3 TBA18 males
- The Top 3 TBA21 females will play the Top 3 TBA18 females
- Each matchup will be a three (3) game Baker teams format event
- The winning team from each matchup will win \$600 in bonus prize money to be shared within the winning athletes.

Team will select order of bowlers, lead off bowler must rotate each game (ie each player, plays in lead off position only once).

Bowler 1 will play frames 1, 4, 7 & 10 Bowler 2 will play frames 2, 5, 8 Bowler 3 will play frames 3, 6, 9


STANDARD RULES & REQUIREMENTS

- All TBA Rules and Regulations will apply.
- Participants must be under the age of 21 years as at 1st January 2023 for TBA21 eligibility and be under the age of 18 years as at 1st January 2023 for TBA18 eligibility.
- All bowlers must be 2023 TBA registered bowlers.
- Ranking points will be allocated to bowlers who are silver members. Bowlers must be silver members a minimum of 24 hours before the first ball is delivered to ensure rankings are applied to performance.
- Dress code appropriate bowling attire to be worn dress shorts for men will be permitted. Jeans, tights or track pants are not acceptable.
- Tie Break procedures for each stage are listed below:
- 1. In Qualifying Should a tie occur for 12th in TBA18, and 8th in TBA21, the highest last game will break the tie.
- 2. Stage 2 tie broken by 9th & 10th frame playoff, if still tied, then sudden death (single frame)
- 3. Finals 9th & 10th playoff, if still tied then sudden death (single frame)
- Any matters not covered here will be decided by the tournament director(s).
- Prize fund will be adjusted based on Entries
- Entries and deposits taken at www.tenpinresults.com.au
- Refund of Entry Fees Should a refund of a players entry fee be required because of an event cancellation or approved refund by the tournament director, the full amount paid will be transferred to the players portal as a credit amount. The player then has two options Use the total credit amount for any other tournament that is using online entries,
 - Request a Cash-out of the total credit amount less the processing fee. (3%)


