APPLICATION & ENTRY FORMS, CLOSING DATES & REFUNDS

A. TBA50 National Masters, TBA50 Graded Cup, and TBA50 Classic Cup

Entries for the TBA50 National Masters, TBA50 Graded Cup, and TBA50 Classic Cup qualifying will open to the public on TenpinResults on approximately 17 August following early access for states, territories and other team groups on www.tenpinresults.com.au.

Initially qualifying attempts will be limited to four (4) per person until one (1) month prior to the event. At that time, remaining squad placings will be open for further re-entry attempts if space permits. Squads can be added or removed at the Tournament Directors discretion to cater for demand. Each squad is limited to 40 people with two (2) per lane.

B. TBA50 Teams Challenge

Application forms to enter the TBA50 Teams Challenge are available at the end of this guide or by emailing rankedevents@tenpin.org.au. Team confirmation is required by the 20 August 2023 and late submissions will be accepted at the discretion of TBA. Confirmed refunds are only payable directly to the team who made the original payment.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Apart from medical aids, no electronic earpieces, headphones, or any other electronic device can be worn or used by players whilst competing. Medical exemptions are available via request to the Tournament Director.

SMOKING & CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL

Will be prohibited during a session of continuous games. Smoking is not allowed inside the venue at any time.

MOBILE PHONES

Competitors mobile phones must be on silent whilst competing at all-times.

NATIONALLY RANKED EVENTS AT TBA50 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

The TBA50 National Masters is a nationally ranked event. Ranking points will be applied for both the senior and grand senior divisions of this event for bowlers who are silver members a minimum of 24 hours prior to the event.

TEAM MANAGER MEETINGS

The Team Manager meeting will be held on Sunday, 22 October 2023 at the AGL National High Performance Centre at 4:00pm local time. Further details to be confirmed and and communicated with Team Managers following the deadline for player registrations.

OPENING CEREMONY

The opening ceremony for the TBA50 Teams Challenge will be held on Monday 23 October 2023 at the AGL National High Performance Centre at 8:30am local time. Team participants are asked to wear their team uniform.

TEAM PHOTOS

Team photos will be taken of all teams during the lane dressing in official practice on Sunday 22 October 2023. Further details to be confirmed and and communicated with Team Managers following the deadline for player registrations.

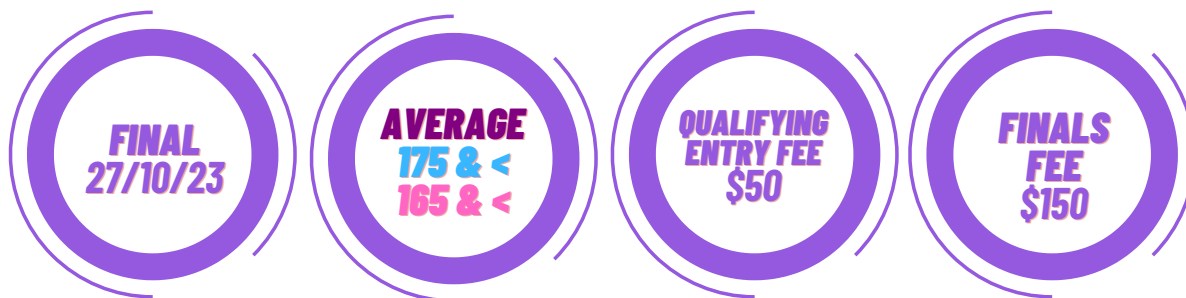

TBA50 GRADED CUP



ELIGIBILITY

This tournament is open to all TBA members and all non-resident players who are a member of an IBF-affiliated federation, in good standing, who must attain the age of 50 years or above in the year of the competition and who have an **average as of the 30th September 2023 of 175 for Men and 165 for Women or below.**

IBF-affiliated federation members must show their proof of federation membership at check-in. There will be a male and female division, and all rules apply to both divisions. Players wishing to bowl average capped events must show proof of their average as of the average date.

AVERAGE

Averages will be taken as of 30th September 2023 – over a minimum of 21 games. Verification of averages by way of a league standing sheet must be provided to the tournament team before qualifying. The Tournament Director reserves the right to regrade bowlers either up or down upon request in writing before commencement of the event.

FORMAT

The Top 10 men and Top 10 women (pinfall plus handicap) following the conclusion of the qualifying squads (3 games) will advance to the final of the TBA50 Graded Cup. In the event of a tie for 10th place, then a 1 game playoff will be held to determine who progresses to the final. The TBA50 Graded Cup will use the handicap of 90% of 200.

FINAL

The top 10 qualifiers will bowl 8 games. At the completion of 8 games, the bowler with the highest scratch pinfall plus handicap will be declared the winner.

TIES

In the event of any tie for the top three positions, a single game will be played to break the tie. Pinfall plus handicap will apply. Any subsequent tie will require a 10th frame playoff plus 1/10 handicap until the tie is broken.

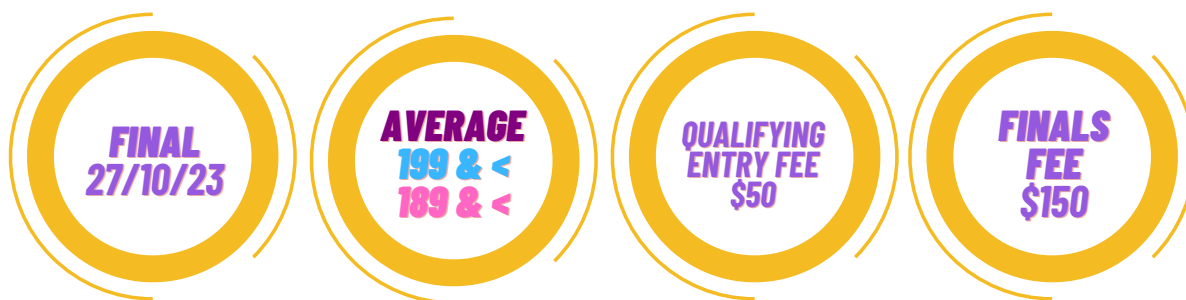
CHECK-IN

Bowlers must check-in 30 minutes prior to the scheduled squad time. Scheduled squad times will be listed on TenpinResults when entries open. Tournament Director has discretion to add/remove squads to cater for demand.

PRIZES

- 1st place - Medallion, & 50% of the Prize fund
- 2nd place - Medallion, & 30 % of the Prize fund
- 3rd place - Medallion and 20% of the Prize fund

TBA50 CLASSIC CUP



ELIGIBILITY

This tournament is open to all TBA members and all non-resident players who are a member of an IBF-affiliated federation, in good standing, who must attain the age of 50 years or above in the year of the competition and who have an **average as of the 30th September 2023 of 199 for Men and 189 for Women or below.**

IBF-affiliated federation members must show their proof of federation membership at check-in. There will be a male and female division, and all rules apply to both divisions. Players wishing to bowl average capped events must show proof of their average as of the average date.

AVERAGE

Averages will be taken as of 30th September 2023 – over a minimum of 21 games.

Verification of averages by way of a league standing sheet must be provided to the tournament team before qualifying. The Tournament Director reserves the right to regrade bowlers either up or down upon request in writing before commencement of the event.

FORMAT

The top 10 men and top 10 women (scratch pinfall) following the conclusion of the qualifying squads (3 games) will also qualify for the final of the TBA50 Classic Cup. In the event of a tie for 10th place, then a 1 game play off will be held to determine who progresses to final

FINAL

The top 10 qualifiers will bowl 8 games. At the completion of 8 games, the bowler with the highest scratch pinfall will be declared the winner.

TIES

In the event of any tie for the top three positions a single game will be played to break the tie. Pinfall will apply. Any subsequent tie will require a 10th frame playoff until the tie is broken.

CHECK-IN

Bowlers must check-in 30 minutes prior to the scheduled squad time. Scheduled squad times will be listed on TenpinResults when entries open. Tournament Director has discretion to add/remove squads to cater for demand.

PRIZES

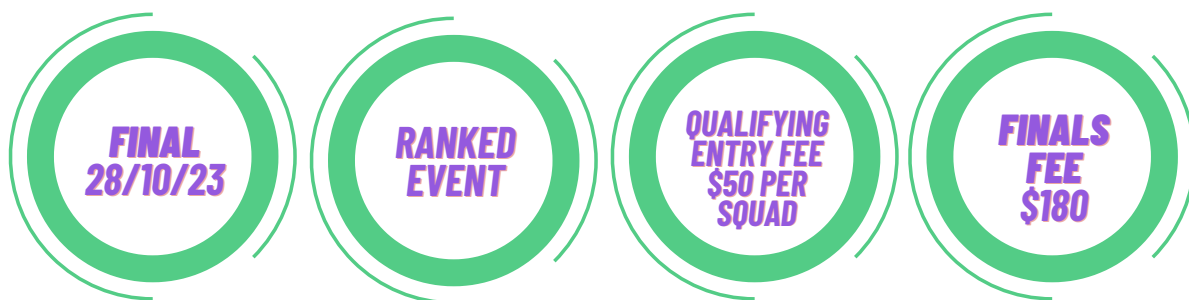
- 1st place - Medallion, & 50% of the Prize fund
- 2nd place - Medallion, & 30 % of the Prize fund
- 3rd place - Medallion and 20% of the Prize fund

PLEASE NOTE

Bowlers that Nominate and Qualify for the Graded & Classic finals are able to bowl in both for a total price of \$225.00 as both finals are run in conjunction with each other.

This format is subject to change at the Tournament Directors' discretion based on the number of entries

TBA50 NATIONAL MASTERS



ELIGIBILITY

This tournament is open to all TBA members and all non-resident players who are a member of an IBF-affiliated federation, in good standing, who must attain the age of 50 years or above in the year of the competition

IBF-affiliated federation members must show their proof of federation membership at check-in. There will be a male and female division, and all rules apply to both divisions.

Competitors must complete two squads of three games for a total of six games for qualifying.

BONUS PRIZE FOR 65+ BOWLERS

Open to all TBA Registered Players who who must attain the age of 65 years or above in the year of the competition. Proof of age may be requested.

At the completion of the TBA50 Masters the top three male and female bowlers who are age eligible will be awarded first, second and third placed for the TBA50 Masters 65+ division. Any ties will be decided on highest Stage 2 game. If a tie still exists, then second highest game will be used and so on.

COST- No additional charge.

PRIZES - 1st - \$200 + medallion, 2nd - \$100 + medallion, 3rd - \$50 + medallion

BOWLING BALLS

1. All bowling balls used in this tournament must be within the specifications defined in chapter 6 of the TBA Rule Book.
2. Each player will be permitted to register a maximum of six bowling balls for this tournament.
3. The completed bowling ball registration form must be online before the tournament's first game. No replacements or additions will be allowed once the bowling ball form has been lodged.
4. Only registered bowling balls for this tournament may be stored in the official ball paddock area provided by Suncity Tenpin.
5. An inspection of any players bowling balls maybe performed at any time and location. A penalty at the complete discretion of the TBA Tournament Team may be applied to any infringement.
6. Players must submit a new form for each tournament played, even if retaining the same Six (6) bowling balls from a previous tournament.

PROTESTS & RESULTS ENQUIRIES

Only competing players directly involved with this event may lodge a protest or results enquiry in relation to this event. This must be lodged in writing and signed to the tournament team within sixty minutes of the completion of the final frame of the tournament. After this time, the results will be considered as final and no further correspondence will be addressed by the tournament team.

FORMAT

TBA reserve the right to modify the event format in the event of not getting a full field.

STAGE 1 - QUALIFYING

Bowlers will complete a total of six games from the qualifying squads in each of the Men and Women's division. The top bowlers based on the best two squads (6 games) will advance to stage two and join the State & Territory Masters as well as the 2022 defending champions. Stage two will see a total of 20 bowlers for each gender compete. E.G. In the male division, If all 9 state and territory representatives are present, plus a defending champion, a total of 10 finalists from qualifying will also advance. Pinfall will carry to stage 2.

STAGE 2

Following the completion of Stage 1 above, all applicable State Seniors Masters Champions and the 2022 TBA Seniors Cup Champions and qualifiers from Stage 1 (to bring the total competitors in each division to 20 bowlers) will bowl a further six games.

Please note state masters and defending champions must bowl two qualifying squad for the purpose of seeding of lane draw. After the completion of stage 2, pinfall will drop for the beginning of stage 3.

STAGE 3 - FINALS

Following the completion of Stage 2, the top 15 men and women from stage 2 on pinfall will bowl an additional seven games in a three-way matchplay format.

POINTS SYSTEM

In the matchplay section, bowlers will compete against each other on a scratch basis, with three bowlers to each pair of lanes, with the highest pinfall winning each match. The participants of each game will receive the following points:

- 4 points – 1st place
- 2 point – 2nd place
- 0 points - 3rd place
- 3 points each - Two way tie for first
- 2 points each - Three way tie for first
- 1 point each - Tie for second and third

The bowlers with the most points after the seven games in each of the men's and women's divisions will be declared the 2023 TBA50 Masters Champions.

Should any bowlers finish on the same points after the seven games, the final positions will be determined by the following tie breaker format.

- Tie breaker for 1st and 2nd to be a 1 game playoff
- If still tied, then a 9th and 10th frame playoff
- If still tied, then sudden death 1 ball
- All other ties will be broken by total pinfall.

PRIZE MONEY (INCLUDING GST)

TBA guarantee to pay equal prize money to males and females, regardless of any differences in final entry numbers.. Male and Female (Estimated and prize fund will be adjusted based on entry numbers). Bowlers eligible for the 65+ bonus that do not cash in the TBA50 masters, the top three from each gender will receive bonus prize money detailed on page page 11 of this guide.

TBA50 TEAMS CHALLENGE

INTRODUCTION

These rules, and the Tenpin Bowling Australia (TBA) rules that do not conflict with the Guide to the event, will apply to the conduct and control of the TBA50 Teams Challenge and related matters. In the event of any state/territory/zone rule conflicting with these rules, then these rules will take precedence.

ORIGIN

The TBA50 Teams Challenge was established in 2007 as the National Seniors Team Challenge. 2023 will see the 16th running of the event.

PURPOSE

The purpose of the TBA50 Teams Challenge is to determine the best state, territory, city, region, centre and/or country representative team of tenpin bowlers, each consisting of 8 players, 4 male and 4 females bowlers per team. To foster, develop and advance a spirit of good sportsmanship, fellowship and gender equality along with promoting and maintaining a good relationship amongst the representative teams. This event supports the senior aged population of bowlers with their own National Team Event.

VENUE

The TBA50 Teams Challenge will be conducted from 22nd October till the 28th October 2023 at AGL National High Performance Centre.

CONTROL OF MATCHES

TBA will appoint the tournament team who will be responsible for all tournament preparations and conduct of the matches whilst in progress.

SPONSORSHIP

Team/s sponsorship is unrestricted, providing it meets national advertising guidelines and regulations. i.e., cigarette advertising is not allowed.

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

1. Must be a financial member of TBA, TBNZ or an IBF-affiliated federation - in goodstanding.
2. Must be capable of conducting themselves in such a manner so as not to reflect discredit on TBA, AGL National High Performance Centre, the team they are representing, or tenpin bowling.
3. Defined as a bowler who has attained the age of 50 years or above in the year of the competition.



TBA50 TEAMS CHALLENGE

STATES, TERRITORIES, CITIES, REGIONS & COUNTRIES TO BE REPRESENTED

Participation in the TBA50 Teams Challenge will be open to teams of four (4) males and four (4) females representing the following:

- Australian Capital Territory - Territory Association
- New South Wales - State Association
- Northern Territory - Territory Association
- TBAQ South - Region
- TBAQ North - Region
- South Australia - State Association
- Tasmania - State Association
- Victoria - State Association
- Western Australia - State Association
- New Zealand - Country
- Any other teams that TBA may wish to invite.

Invited State Associations may apply to TBA to include an additional team (subject to approval of TBA)

TEAM REGISTRATION & INVITATIONS

1. State and Territory Associations receive two teams (male and female) automatically. Each state and territory association must advise TBA, using the TBA50 Teams Challenge Team registration form by [clicking here](#). Teams intending to field teams need to submit a registration form by 20 August 2023
2. TBNZ receives an automatic invitation for 2 TBA50 Teams Challenge Squads.
3. Any state or territory association, regional and/or city association, party, group, league, business, TBA affiliated bowling centre, country or individual can apply for an invitational team.
4. Registration deadlines
5. Entry fee is \$1,600 per team including GST.
 - Team Registration – 20 August 2023
 - Team Payments - 30 September 2023

SELECTION OF TEAMS

1. Teams can be selected by the respective team management in any format or criteria they choose.
2. The roster of players for each male and female team in the TBA50 Teams Challenge must be four (4) male and four (4) female players. Associations or Invitations are automatically given one team (4 men and 4 women) and can request a further team of four (4).
3. A minimum of 2 players in each team must either be current residents of or born in the state, territory, or country where the team is based. Up to two players in each team may be selected from any location, providing they meet the player eligibility rules outlined in the Player Eligibility section on the previous page.

TEAM UNIFORMS

1. State & Territory Association teams, TBA and TBNZ teams retain the first right to use their respective state and national colours in their entirety. Other Invitational teams may use one only of these state colours in their shirt and uniform designs, representative of their region.
2. All teams must wear a team jacket using the same or similar colours to the team shirt.
3. All players must wear their approved team shirt whilst playing. Male teams may wear long pants or knee-length shorts. Female teams may wear long or 3/4 pants, knee-length shorts or skirts. All players in the team must wear the same uniform at the same time in terms of style and colours. i.e. if wearing shorts for example, all players must be wearing shorts and these must be the same colour and style.
4. The TBA logo must be visible on the left-hand sleeve of each team shirt, to be located 25mm above the end of the sleeve. The size of the logo should be a minimum of 110mm wide and 45mm high.
5. Teams have the freedom to choose their own design and layout, including the placements of sponsor logos.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

All Teams will bowl a series of Medal events which include:

- Men's Singles - 6 Games
- Women's Singles - 6 Games
- Men's Doubles - 6 Games
- Women's Doubles - 6 Games
- Men's Teams of Four - 6 Games
- Women's Teams of Four - 6 games

1. A points table will be kept of the total points earned.
2. If bowling unopposed, Individuals in a team line-up will be required to bowl 180 (or more) for males and 170 (or more) for females in the match to win the individual matchpoint.

POINTS SYSTEM

Please find the points system that will be used for appointing points for performances in each of the medal events of the TBA50 Teams Challenge.

TBA50 TEAMS CHALLENGE SHIELD

The highest placed male team (4) on points will win the Male division TBA50 Teams Challenge Trophy while the highest placed female team (4) on points will win the Female division TBA50 Team Challenge Trophy. The team with the highest combined male and female points score will win the Combined trophy. Trophies will be presented to the champion teams immediately after the tournament.

These trophies are perpetual and remain the property of the TBA. The champion teams can take the awards back to their home region for local publicity purposes on the condition of satisfactory and safe return to TBA within 9 months of the tournament's completion.

MEDALLIONS

For each event and the overall Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals will be presented to the Players Coach and Manager.

INDIVIDUAL TROPHIES

The following individual trophies will be awarded:

TBA50 Team Challenge All-Star Team

Following each TBA50 Team Challenge, an "All-Star Team" will be announced in both divisions. Selection of the All-Stars will be based on the top five male and top five females on total individual pinfall over the 18 games (6 singles, 6 doubles, 6 teams)

TBA50 Teams Challenge Sportperson's Award

Voting forms will be distributed to team managers at the beginning of the final day of play. Voting is on a preferential voting system where (3) is the first preference. Only one form per team can be filled in, relevant to your division, and voting forms must be returned to the tournament room by the commencement of the last game of the tournament. Any forms received after this time will not be included in the total votes. Voting for players within your own team is not allowed, as is voting for players in the other division of the tournament. The player in each division who receives the most votes will be declared the winner of the award in that division. A tie for points will be decided by the number of "3"s received and if still equal, the number of "2"s. Winners of the male and female Sportperson's Awards will be announced at the presentation dinner.
