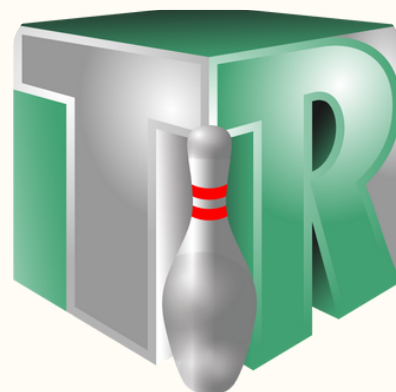

FORMAT & SCHEDULE

SATURDAY 17 FEBRUARY 2024

- Lanes oiled
- Squad A check in by 11:30 am for a 12:00 pm start of Stage 1
- Stage 1: Bowl 9 games (3x3 game blocks)

SUNDAY 18 FEBRUARY 2024

- Check in by 8:15am for 8:30am start. Lanes oiled
- Stage 2: All participants bowl a further 3 games
- At the conclusion of Stage 2, the field cuts to the top 8 male and top 8 females to compete in the matchplay finals
- Pinfall drops for the commencement of matchplay finals
- Lanes oiled
- Matchplay Finals - Top 8 Males and Top 8 Females bowl 7 games of matchplay + positional round (8 games)
- Points system adopted for Matchplay Finals - 2 points for a win, 1 for a tie, and 0 for a loss.
- Ties for 1st and 2nd decided by a 1 game playoff if required. All other ties decided by highest pinfall from matchplay round.
- The Male and Female bowler with the most points at the conclusion of the Matchplay Finals will be crowned 2024 TBA Inclusion Cup champions.



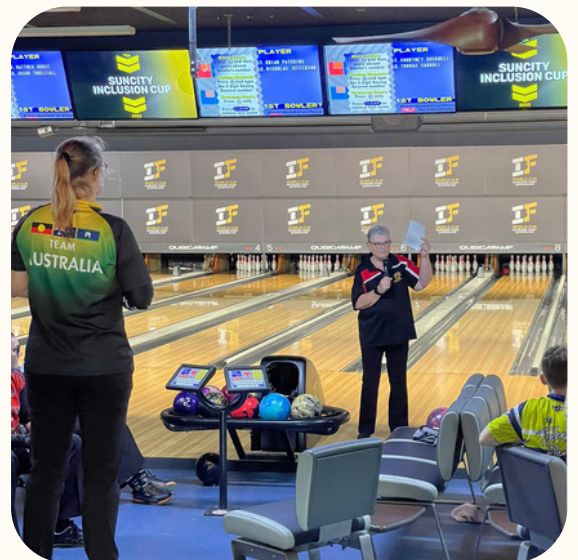

Rules & Regulations

- This is a scratch event that is open to all 2024 TBA registered bowlers who have a disability. TBA defines a bowler with a disability “as a person who suffers from a condition that has limitation, restriction or impairment that restricts everyday activity. The condition is permanent. It should be noted that degree or degrees of pain are not considered a disability.
- If requested, to prove a disability, a bowler needs to provide one the types of evidence listed in RULE 214 - Disability Definition of, in the TBA League, Tournament & General Playing Rules of, in the TBA League, Tournament & General Playing Rules
- Any bowler who is unsure of their eligibility to compete should apply to the Tournament Director for final ruling. Bowlers may be asked to provide written medical information. It is the bowler’s responsibility to ensure evidence in support of their disability can be produced. Failure to produce acceptable evidence may result in disqualification with further participation in the tournament not permitted. with further participation in the tournament not permitted.
- All games will be bowled in accordance with TBA rules and regulations.
- TBA Inclusion ranking points will be allocated to bowlers who are silver members at least 24 hours prior to the tournament commencing (League/Junior registration + Silver Upgrade).
- TBA registration checks will be checked prior to the commencement of the event
- Entry Fee: \$230 via the TenpinResults portal – a \$90 deposit is required at the time of entry nomination, with the balance to be paid by 3 February 2024.
- Refund of Entry Fees – Should a refund of a player’s entry fee be required because of an event cancellation or approved refund by the tournament director, the full amount will be transferred to the player’s portal as a credit amount. The player then has two options:
 - 1) Use the total credit amount for any other tournament that is using online entries on TenpinResults
 - 2) Request a Cash-Out of the total credit amount less the processing fee (3%)
- Dress code – appropriate bowling attire to be worn – dress shorts for men will be permitted. Jeans, tights, or track pants are not acceptable.
- The Tournament Director and TBA reserve the right to check any bowler’s equipment at any time. Any equipment to be found to breach TBA regulations will result in disqualification with no claim on any prize money.
- Any bowler that fails to check in on Saturday 17 February or the Matchplay final on Sunday 18 February will be replaced by the first available reserve.
- Any matters not covered in these conditions will be decided by the Tournament Director whose decision will be final.
- Smoking, Consumption of alcohol and use of mobile phones while competing are not permitted.
- Ties for 1st and 2nd at the end of the Matchplay finals will be decided by a 1-game playoff. All other ties will be decided by highest pinfall from Matchplay round.
- Ties for 8th place to qualify for the Matchplay finals will be decided by a 1-game playoff. If tie remains, a 9th and 10th Frame playoff will be activated. If a tie still remains, a sudden death roll-off will occur until the tie is broken.
- Eligibility for the Most Over Average prizes requires participants to show proof of established average (21 games) at check in.
- Winners of the Most Over Average prizes are for bowlers that do not finish in the tournament cash positions.
