



TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

- This is a scratch event which is open to all 2022 TBA Registered Players. All games will be bowled in accordance with TBA Rules & Regulations. 2022 TBA registered player cards must be presented at check-in.
- Ranking points will be allocated to bowlers who are silver members prior to their first ball being bowled during the tournament.
- Refund of Entry Fees – Should a refund of a players entry fee be required because of an event cancellation or approved refund by the tournament director, the full amount paid will be transferred to the players portal as a credit amount. The player then has two options
 - Use the total credit amount for any other tournament that is using online entries,
 - Request a Cash-out of the total credit amount less the processing fee. (3%)
- Female bowlers will receive 8 pins per game in all stages and finals.
- Dress code - appropriate bowling attire to be worn - dress shorts for men will be permitted. Jeans, tights or track pants are not acceptable.
- The Tournament Director reserves the right to check any bowler's equipment at any time. Any equipment found to breach TBA regulations will result in disqualification with no claim on any prize money.
- Any bowler not checking in for Stages 2, 3, or the final will be replaced by the first available reserve.
- Any matters not covered in these conditions will be decided by the Tournament Directors whose decision will be final.
- SMOKING, CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL & USE OF MOBILE PHONES WHILE COMPETING IS NOT PERMITTED.
- This centre is TBA registered, and has a government approved Covid plan or guideline in place.
- This accredited event will be held in accordance with any current guidelines as set out by state/territory government, ensuring centre capacity and social distancing requirements are adhered to.
- ~TIES~
 A tie for 32nd place after Stage 1 (qualifying) will be decided by the highest last game in Stage 1.
 A tie for 16th place after Stage 2 will be decided by the highest last game in Stage 2. A tie for 8th place after Stage 3 will be decided by a one game playoff at the completion of Stage 3. If a tie still exists, a 10th frame playoff will occur until the tie is broken.
 If a tie occurs during any round of the final (excl. the final round) a 10th frame playoff will occur until the tie is broken.
 If a tie exists for 1st place at the conclusion of the FINALS, a one game playoff will take place. If a tie still exists, a 10th frame playoff will occur until the tie is broken.
