# SATURDAY QUALIFYING

16th November

A SQUAD CHECK IN BY 12:00PM

B SQUAD CHECK IN BY 4:00PM

All Bowlers bowl 10 games qualifying. (5 Blocks x 2 games)

Top 12 male & top 12 female advance to Stage 2 (pinfall carries)



## SUNDAY CHECK IN BY 8:45AM

17th November

**STAGE 2:** Top 12 male & Top 12 female after qualifying bowl a further 4 games. (4 blocks x 1 game)

Top 8 male & top 8 female advance to Stage 3 (pinfall drops)

**STAGE 3: ELIMINATOR FINALS**

**ROUND 1 Final** 1v4 / 2v3 / 5v8 / 6v7 - 2 Games

**ROUND 2 Final** Winners from 1v4 & 2v3 have a bye. Winners from 5v8 & 6v7 play losers from the 1v4 & 2v3 matches - 1 Game

**ROUND 3 Final** Winners from Round 1 (1v4 & 2v3) play Winners from Round 2 - 1 Game

**THE FINAL** Winners from Round 3 play a 1 Game Final

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

- All TBA Rules and Regulations will apply.
- Participants must be under the age of 21 years as at 1st January 2024.
- All bowlers must be 2024 TBA registered bowlers.
- Ranking points - Bowlers are required to be silver members at least 24 hours prior to the event commencing.
- Dress code - appropriate bowling attire to be worn.
  - dress shorts for men will be permitted. Jeans, tights or track pants are not acceptable.
- In the event of any ties, a tie for 1st place will be decided by a 1 game play off, if a tie occurs for 12th place male or 12th place female after qualifying, or 8th place after stage 2, the highest last game will decide the tie. If a tie occurs in any matches from stage 3 (excluding the final), a 10th frame rolloff will occur until the tie is broken.
- Any matters not covered here will be decided by the tournament director(s).
- Prize fund is based on 48 bowlers (30 male & 18 female).
- Entries and deposits taken at [www.tenpinresults.com.au](http://www.tenpinresults.com.au) \$100 deposit required to secure entry, with the balance to be paid 2 weeks prior to event.
- Refund of Entry Fees – Should a refund of a players entry fee be required because of an event cancellation or approved refund by the tournament director, the full amount paid will be transferred to the players portal as a credit amount. The player then has two options
  - Use the total credit amount for any other tournament that is using online entries,
  - Request a Cash-out of the total credit amount less the processing fee. ( 3% )
