RULES

All TBA Tournament Rules and Regulations will apply unless in conflict with any rules and regulations outlined in this guide. Tournament Accreditation number A24/0227. The TBA50 tournament team will determine any matters that are not covered in this guide.





ELIGIBILITY

This tournament is open to all TBA members and all non-resident players who are a member of an IBF affiliated federation, in good standing, who must attain the age of 50 years or above in the year of the competition. IBF affiliated federation members must show their proof of federation membership at check-in. There will be a male and female division, and all rules apply to both divisions. Competitors must complete two squads of 6 games for a total of 12 games as a qualification attempt to make the top 16.

NATIONAL TRAINING SQUAD TRIALS

Please note the TBA50 National Masters has been marked as the event for 2025 National Training Squad trials. Involvement in the Trial's is only open to Australian based residents. More information to be released.

STAGE 1 - QUALIFYING

Qualifying will see bowlers complete a total of 6 games in two appearances on different oil patterns for a total of 12 qualifying games.

At the end of all scheduled qualifying squads, the top 16 for each division will be finalised and these bowlers will advance to stage 2 of the tournament.

Ties: If any ties exist to advance to Stage 2, a 1 game playoff will occur.

STAGE 2

The top 16 bowlers from stage 1 qualifying will advance to stage 2 for an additional four games. Pinfall to carry.

At the conclusion of stage 2 four games, the field will be cut to the top 8 to advance to the next stage for each division.

Ties: If any ties exist to advance to Stage 3, the highest last game will be used to break the tie.

STAGE 3 - MATCH PLAY FINALS

The top 8 from each division after stage 2 will advance to the match play finals where athletes will bowl seven games of match play with pinfall carrying from stage 2 and bonus pins activated. Bonus pins will be 20 pins awarded for a win and 10 for a tie.

The bowler with the highest pinfall at the conclusion of all 7 match play games will be crowned the 2024 TBA50 National Masters Champion.

Ties: If any ties exist, the highest last game will be used to break the tie.

COST

- Entry Fee is \$280



BONUS PRIZE FOR 65+ BOWLERS

Open to all TBA registered bowlers who must attain the age of 65 or above in the year of the competition. Proof of age may be requested.

At the completion of the TBA50 National Masters the top 3 male and female bowlers eligible will be awarded first, second, and third place for the TBA50 National Masters 65+ division. Any ties will be decided on highest stage 2 game. If a tie still exists, then second highest game in stage 2 will be used and so on.

Cost - No additional charge

Prizes - 1st - \$200 + medallion, 2nd - \$100 + medallion, 3rd - \$50 + medallion

BOWLING BALLS

- All bowling balls used in this tournament must be within the specifications defined in chapter 6 of the TBA Rule Book.
- Each player will be permitted to register a maximum of six bowling balls for this tournament.
- The completed bowling ball registration form must be completed online before the tournament's first game.
- No replacements or additions will be allowed once the bowling ball form has been lodged.
- Only registered bowling balls for this tournament may be stored in the official ball paddock area provided by Suncity Tenpin.
- An inspection of any players bowling balls may be performed at any time and location. A penalty at the complete discretion of the TBA Tournament Team may be applied to any infringement.
- Changes to the surface of balls must comply with TBA Rule 602.

PROTESTS & RESULTS ENQUIRIES

Only competing players directly involved with this event may lodge a protest or results enquiry in relation to this event. This must be lodged in writing and signed to the tournament team within sixty minutes of the completion of the final frame of the tournament. After this time, the results will be considered as final and no further correspondence will be addressed by the tournament team.

RANKINGS

This is a nationally ranked event for the TBA Senior and Grand Senior divisions in 2024. Those wishing to have their performances receive ranking points must be a full silver member (league + silver upgrade) a minimum of 24 hour prior to the event commencing.

ENTRIES

Entries will be processed on the TenpinResults portal and will open to the public on **TBC**. All State Master representatives from 2024 and Defending champions from 2023 will be guaranteed a position in qualifying. Initially qualifying attempts will be limited to three (3) per person until 1 month prior to the event. At that time, remaining squad placings will be open for further re-entry attempts if space permits. Squads can be added or removed at the Tournament Directors discretion to cater for demand. Each squad is limited to 40 people with 2 bowlers per lane.



ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Apart from medical aids, no electronic earpieces, headphones, or any other electronic device can be worn or used by players whilst competing. Medical exemptions are available via request to the Tournament Director.

SMOKING & CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL

Will be prohibited during a session of continuous games. Smoking is not allowed inside the venue at any time.

MOBILE PHONES

Competitors mobile phones must be on silent whilst competing at all-times.

CURRENCY & PRIZE MONEY

All prices and prize money in this document are expressed in Australian dollars (AUD) and are inclusive of GST for tax purposes.

SQUAD & CHECK-IN TIMES

Please refer to the schedule of events for further information. Squads may be added and/or removed at any time, subject to entries, at the discretion of the TBA50 Tournament team.

Check-in times for each qualification squad is 30 minutes prior to block 1 of the scheduled start time of the squad. Check-in is also required 30 min prior to the commencement of stage 2.

REFUND POLICY

NO REFUND AFTER ENTRIES CLOSE - Teams or Individuals who do not bowl in their allocated squads will not be entitled to claim a refund. Teams or Individuals who are unable to bowl in their event, can sell their spot to another competitor. Whilst the Tournament Committee will help where possible to reschedule entries, it is not the responsibility of the Tournament Committee to sell or recover money for unused entries.




