2024 Mackay Junior Restricted Masters

This is a handicap tournament bowled in two divisions (male and female) open to all junior bowlers who comply with the eligibility clause whose average does not exceed 145 for males and 135 for females.

Handicap to be used will be 100% of 300.

All bowlers will bowl 6 games (3 blocks of 2 games)
The bowler with the highest pinfall plus handicap over the 6 games will be declared the 2024 Restricted Masters winner.

Any ties for 1st, 2nd or 3rd Place will be decided by the highest last game, plus handicap.

The top three restricted bowlers will receive:

Rules and Regulations:

Format

- Restricted and Open bowlers will bowl 6 games (3 blocks of 2 games) in their respective divisions.
- At the end of 6 games, open divisions will bowl one final block of 2 games.
- All Bowlers will move lanes after 2 games; left lane moving 2 lanes left and right lane moving 2 lanes right.
- Lanes will be oiled at the start of play, there is no re-oiling during between blocks.
- Bowlers are limited to six (6) balls.
- No ball is allowed to be resurfaced once play commences.

Eligibility

This tournament is open to all juniors who:

- are current TBA registered bowlers,
- are bowling in a TBA scheduled league at the Mackay Leisure Centre
- are in good financial standing with the TBMA.
- are currently residing in the Mackay Area for a period of 3 months immediately prior to closing date of Masters.
- has not reached the age of 18 years on January 1st of the current year.

Bowlers can only nominate for one division.

Each division must have a minimum of 3 nominations.

Averages to use

The average to be used is the highest league average from a minimum of 24 games across all Mackay leagues as of 17th November 2024.

Bowlers without an Average

A bowler without a 24 game average must apply to the Tournament Coordinator for an average to be assigned. All relevant information required by the Coordinator, to assign an average, must be supplied by the bowler. Application must be made prior to closing date of entries

Rules

This is an accredited event and all TBA tournament rules, regulations and the Code of Ethics will apply. All other matters which may arise and are not covered in these Tournament Rules will be decided by the Tournament Directors.

No smoking or consumption of alcohol is permitted whilst bowling in the tournament.

Personal entertainment systems (mp3, iPods, iPads, etc.) will not be allowed in the players' area.

The use of mobile phones and/or 'apps' will not be permitted in the players' area.

Unsporting conduct will not be tolerated.

Only bowlers participating in the tournament are permitted in the player's area during the tournament.

Refund of Entry Fees

Should a refund be required because of an event cancellation or approved refund by the tournament director, the full amount paid will be transferred to the players portal as a credit amount. The player then has two options:

- a) Use the total credit amount for any other tournament that is using online entries,
- b) Request a cash-out of the total credit amount less the processing fee. (3%)

Bowler Conduct

Competitors must be capable of conducting themselves in such a manner so as not to reflect negatively on TBA, NQJC, TBMA or the sport of Tenpin Bowling.

The Tournament Director has the right to penalise bowlers for violations of the TBA Code of Ethics.

The yellow/red card system will be in force throughout this event.

Dress Code

- Neat tidy acceptable bowling attire is required.
- No denim will be allowed.
- No leggings of any variety will be allowed.
- Skirts/Shorts of appropriate length as at tournament directors' discretion.
- Tournament director's decision shall be final.
