Tournament Conditions

- 1. This is a TBA Ranked Event open to female bowlers who are 2025 registered members of TBA. All games will be bowled in accordance with TBA rules and regulations.
- 2. Bowlers must be TBA registered when completing their online entry. No bowler is permitted to have more than one entry in this event.
- 3. Ranking points will only be allocated to bowlers who are registered Silver members 24 hours before the tournament begins.
- 4. Bowlers must wear acceptable attire. Jeans and track pants are not acceptable. Dress shorts and 3/4 pants are accepted.
- 5. Should a tie occur for 10th place after qualifying or for 1st place after the finals, the tie will be decided by a one-game play-off. Should a tie still exist after the play-off, the 9th & 10th frame will be bowled until the tie is decided.
- The Tournament Directors reserve the right to check any bowler's equipment at any time. Any
 equipment found to breach TBA regulations will result in disqualification with no claim on any prize
 money.
- 7. In the Graded Division, the highest league average as at the 31st December 2024 will be used for qualifying. The handicap applied will be 90% of 200. The average must be achieved in a registered centre. The Tournament Directors reserve the right to re-average entrants if necessary.
- 8. Bowlers are not permitted to smoke in-between games and must wait until the full completion of their squad before doing so.
- 9. No mobile phones, ear-pieces, or scoring applications to be used in the players area.
- 10. Any matters not covered in these conditions will be decided by the Tournament Directors.

Qualifying Format

All bowlers will bowl 16 games qualifying in **B squad** (8 games Friday, 8 games Saturday), in 4 x 2-game blocks each day.

At the completion of qualifying:

- In the Scratch Division, the top 10 bowlers on pinfall will advance to the matchplay finals, and
- In the Graded Division, the top 10 bowlers on pinfall with handicap will advance to the matchplay finals.

Finals Pairings

1st placed Open bowler will be paired with the 10th placed Graded bowler, 2nd placed Open bowler will be paired with the 9th placed Graded bowler, and so on, until all 10 pairs are formed.

VIC 150 Finals - Pinfall will carry over for both Scratch and Graded Bowlers

Graded bowlers will be re-averaged prior to matchplay commencing, based on their pinfall for 16 qualify games + 10 games x entering average.

The 10 Finals pairings will bowl 9 games matchplay with a bonus system of 20 pins for a win, 10 pins for a draw, and zero pins for a loss.

At the completion of the 9 matchplay games, the pairing with the highest pinfall (including handicap and bonuses) will be declared the "2025 Vic-150 Co-Champions"

Entries

All entries and payments must be made online via tenpinresults.com.au

Entries and payments will not be accepted in centre, via EFT, or social media.

Entry Fee: \$300 - including a \$75.00 non-refundable deposit with entry nomination.

The remining balance must be paid in full by the 28th of March 2025.

Any bowler who has not paid in full by 28th of March will be moved to a waiting list until full payment has been made.

Refunds

Should a refund of a bowler's entry fee be required due to event cancellation or otherwise approved by the tournament directors, the full amount paid will be transferred to the bowler's tenpinresults portal as a credit amount.

The bowler then has two options:

- Use the total credit amount for any other tournament that is using online entries via tenpinresults, or
- Request a cash-out of the total credit amount less the processing fee (3%) via tenpinresults
