HOST VENUE

The 2025 TBA21 National Masters will be held at the AGL National High Performance Centre on the Sunshine Coast in Queensland from the 19-20 July 2025.

ELIGIBILITY

The TBA21 National Masters is open to all 2025 TBA members in good standing and all non-resident bowlers who are a member of an affiliated federation who have not reached their 21st Birthday on the 1st January 2025.

This is a TBA Youth Division nationally ranked event for 2025.

COST

The full entry fee for the TBA21 National Masters is \$290 and \$100 deposit will be required to reserve your spot on TenpinResults with the balance due 4 July 2025.

REFUND POLICY

NO REFUND AFTER ENTRIES CLOSE - Individuals who do not bowl in their allocated squads will not be entitled to claim a refund. Individuals who are unable to bowl in their event, can sell their spot to another competitor. Whilst the Tournament Committee will help where possible to reschedule entries, it is not the responsibility of the Tournament Committee to sell or recover money for unused entries.



STAGE 1 - QUALIFYING

All bowlers will bowl a total of 8 games in one appearance/squad, changing lanes after each game, even lanes one pair to the right, odd lanes one pair to the left. All play will be on a TBA approved pattern. The top 12 males and top 12 females based on scratch pinfall after qualifying will advance to stage 2. Pinfall will drop. The top 4 performing bowlers in the TBA21 National Teams Challenge All-Events for each gender will receive automatic qualification to stage 2's Matchplay final. The Top 4 All-Stars will still be required to pay entry fee but gets an express pass to stage 2. Entry numbers may require up to 5 bowlers per pair on some lanes.

Ties for 12th position to advance will be broken by one game between the tied bowlers. The tie-breaker match will take place immediately after last match in the stage has been played. Additional ties will be broken by a 9th and 10th frame roll-off. If more than two athletes are tied to advance one game will be played by all tied bowlers and highest score (s) will advance.

STAGE 2- GROUP MATCHPLAY FINALS

The top 12 males and top 12 females will join the top 4 All-Stars from the 2025 TBA21 National Teams Challenge for each gender in this stage equaling 16 bowlers in each gender for this stage.

The 16 bowlers for each gender will be seperated into two groups of eight (8) bowlers. The TBA21 Teams Challenge All-Stars will be seeded 1-4 and the top 12 from qualifying will be seeds 5-12.

Each group will play 7 Round Robin matches. 3 points will be awarded for a win in a match, 1 for a tie. The top 2 bowlers on points from each of the two groups will advance to the Final Four semi-finals. Ties in a group to advance will be broken by a one game between the tied bowlers. The tie-breaker match will take place immediately after last group match has been played. Additional ties will be broken by a 9th and 10th frame roll-off. If more than two athletes are tied to advance one game will be played by all tied bowlers and highest score (s) will advance.



STAGE 3 - FINAL FOUR SEMI-FINALS

Four bowlers qualify from Group Matchplay. Semi-finals will be played over best of three games. In the event of a tie in a game a 9th 10th frame roll-off will occur to break the tie. Winners advance to the TBA21 National Masters Final.

STAGE 4 - FINAL

Two bowlers qualify from semi-finals. Final will be played over best of three games. In the event of a tie in any game, a 9th 10th frame roll-off will occur to break the tie. Bowlers will play on one pair of lanes, other bowler per lane. Highest ranked bowler from Group Matchplay gets to choose starting lane (left or right) after warm-up. Ties for seeding will be broken by total pinfall in qualification.



RULES

- 1. This event is open to all 2025 TBA members in good standing and all non-resident bowlers who are a member of an affiliated federation who have not reached their 21st birthday on the 1st January 2025.
- 2.This event will be a nationally ranked tournament. Bowlers outside of Stage 2 Matchplay Final will receive ranking points based on their qualifying position. Any bowlers wishing to receive Ranking points must have purchased the 2025 TBA Silver upgrade sports registration 24 hours prior to the events commencement.
- 3.Bowlers are required to check-in with the tournament team prior to the designated squad time each day of the tournament. Play will commence after a short briefing.
- 4.TBA Rules and Regulations, including the Code of Ethics, shall apply at all times.
- 5. Changes to the surface of balls must comply with TBA Rule 602.
- 6.No Smoking is permitted whilst a bowler is participating in the event until either the end of the day's play or the bowler is eliminated from the event.
- 7.Any bowler wishing to leave the lanes during a block of games during the tournament must first obtain the permission of the Tournament Director or an event official.
- 8.Only competing players directly involved with this event may lodge a protest or results enquiry in relation to this event. This must be lodged in writing and signed to the tournament team within sixty minutes of the completion of the final frame of the tournament. After this time, the results will be considered as final and no further correspondence will be addressed by the tournament team.
- 9.All bowlers must wear a shirt with an upright or turned over collar or bowling industry manufactured shirt. Males may wear long dress pants or neat dress shorts. Females may wear slacks, shorts, skirts, 3/4 dress pants or skorts. No jeans, cargo pants, tracksuit pants, leggings, T shirts, tank tops, or hats are to be worn whilst competing unless an exemption to the dress rules has been sought from the Tournament Director prior to the commencement of the event.
- 10. Bowlers not checked in by the advertised time will be disqualified and will have no claim on any prize money.
- 11. Any errors in scoring must be advised to the Tournament Director prior to the Prize Fund presentation. After that time all positions and payouts will remain as presented.
- 12. Please Note: TBA will be taking photographs and video throughout the 2025 TBA21 National Masters. If you do not wish for your image to be used, please advise the Tournament Director upon arrival.
- 13. These rules, together with TBA rules and regulations will apply.




