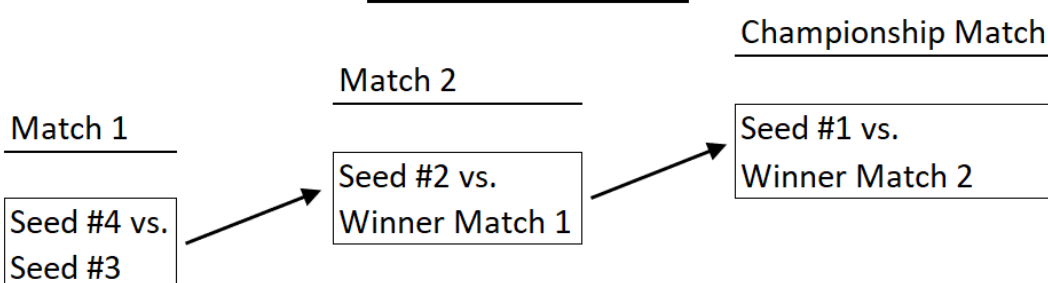
\$200 for the highest placed junior outside the cut in each division

Tournament Rules + Conditions

- This is a TBA accredited event and all TBA rules and regulations will apply. This accredited event will be held in accordance with any current government guidelines set out and ensuring centre capacity and social distancing requirements are adhered to.
- This is a scratch event open to all current 2022 TBA members and bowlers are to provide proof of membership upon check-in. This is an event with an open and female division.
- This centre is TBA registered and has a government approved Covid plan in place for all areas.
- Bowlers must wear neat, acceptable attire. No jeans, singlets, hats, etc.
- This is a dual-pattern event which consists of two 'mystery' patterns. Pattern A on the left (odd lanes) and Pattern B on the right (even lanes).
- In qualifying, bowlers will bowl 10 games and will be bowled in 5 x 2 game blocks changing 2 pairs after each block (subject to change based on bowlers per squad). This will be conducted in 3 squads: a, b and c. Squads are maxed at 28 bowlers each.
- After qualifying the field will cut to the top 24 open and top 12 ladies. The top 12 in the open and ladies division will get a bye and go straight into stage 3. However, bowlers 13-24 in the open division will bowl stage 2. Stage 2 will use their qualifying pinfall carried over, however the total pinfall after stage 2 will not be used for stage 3.
- Stage 2 will be a 4 game sprint, total pinfall, between bowlers 13-24 for the open division. This will be bowled in 1 game blocks, moving 1 pair. The top 4 from stage 2, will progress through to join bowlers 1-12 from the open division in stage 3. These combined will make the top 16 open for stage 3 and pinfall from stage 2 will be dropped.
- Stage 3 will be the top 16 open and the top 12 ladies with re oil. Total pinfall after qualifying will be used for everyone for stage 3 as pinfall from stage 2 will not be used. This stage will consist of 6 games in 2 game blocks, moving 2 pairs.
- Stage 4 will cut to the top 9 for both divisions and will have no re oil. Head-to-head, tri match-play format with bonus pins awarded for 1st (20), 2nd (10), 3rd (0) for each match (pinfall carries).
- The stepladder finals will be 4th seed vs. 3rd seed, winner plays 2nd seed, the next winner will play the no.1 seed in the stepladder final for both the ladies and open. All matches will be 1 game total pinfall. 2 pairs are oiled for the stepladders and 1 pair for practice using both 'mystery' patterns as it has been throughout the event.
- All stepladder matches will be played on the same two pairs. The next opponent (2) will have practice on the practice pair once the first match has reached the 6th frame. This will repeat for the 1st seed. The new bowler/s coming to the match pair will have 2 frames practice on each lane. Before starting the match the higher seed will choose their starting lane and who starts first. The two winners of the final stepladder matches will be crowned the 2022 Logan City Cup Champions.
- In case of a tie after qualifying, stage 2 or 3, the seeding will come down to the highest last game bowled to break the tie. If there is a tie for any position to make the stepladder, a 9th/10th frame roll-off will occur to break the tie.
- Prize fund will be adjusted accordingly based on actual entries.
- All schedule times are approximate and may deviate depending on circumstances. Squad check-in times will NOT change and bowlers MUST check-in before the allocated time. Late entries won't be permitted.
- Any other conflicts, problems or other issues, rules, regulations not stated here or in the TBA rules will be under the discretion of the tournament director/s or centre management.
- Entries, deposits, squad lists and live scores will be organised through www.tenpinresults.com.au
- Should a refund of a players entry fee be required because of an event cancellation or approved refund by the tournament director, the full amount paid will be transferred to the players portal as a credit amount. The player then has two options:
 - Use the total credit amount for any other tournament that is using online entries,
 - Request a Cash-out of the total credit amount less the processing fee. (3%)
