Conditions of Entry:

Participants must wear a Skill Bowling shirt (purchased from the website) throughout the tournament, and one Skill 3.02 ball must be used.

Late entries may be accepted at tournament directors discretion.

Event qualifying will consist of 18 games in 3 squads of 6 x 1 game blocks.


Top 8 bowlers on pinfall will progress to knock out stage in best of 3 head to head matches as per the schedule.

Tie breaking rules should be as follows:

- Ties for the progression of the tournament from qualifying to the final shall be determined by highest last game
- Ties that dont effect progression shall be determined by highest last game
- be determined by a "golden strike play off.
 the Higher seed shall pick the starting lane or
 to begin first, the other seed shall choose the
 remaining option. Both bowlers will then bowl
 1 ball on the same lane, the match conclueds
 when one person strikes and the other person
 does not. should neither strike in the first
 frame. then they shall move to the alternate
 lane and continue the process one person is
 victorious.



POS RULES

TO PARTICIPATE IN TEEN MASTERS, YOU MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

AGE: You must be 19 years or younger on the 7th February 2026.

AMATEUR: You must be an amateur bowler. Members of the PBA and/or PWBA are ineligible. USBC adult and PBA Jr. membership do not impact eligibility.

MEMBER: You must be a member of Skill Bowling Australia/ New Zealand or the Middle East and a member of Tenpin Bowling Australia



2025 BOWLING BALLS

- All participants are limited to using one (1) bowling ball at the 2025 Championships. Balls weighing 13-15 pounds must be the SKILL 3.02. Bowlers may use a 12 or 16-pound Storm Mix.
- Participants may only introduce a second ball if the Tournament Director determines the original ball has been damaged beyond repair through regular use in the bowling center. A bowler who intentionally damages or destroys their bowling ball will be disqualified.
- Maximum static finger/thumb/side weight is 1 oz.
- Balance/weight holes are prohibited Balls may be plugged and re-drilled.
- Interchangeable thumb inserts are allowed but void any warranty as the large hole(s) make the balls susceptible to cracking.

SMLEH HLLING

Bowlers with the athletic ability to switch from right to left or left to right may do so at any time during Teen Masters competition.






WRIST SUPPORT DEVICES

Because Teen Masters believes that ball motion variations are the bowler's responsibility, wrist supports containing plastic, metal, or pads are prohibited. Gloves that do not contain rigid metal, plastic, or a pad are allowed. Wrist tape is permitted.

NO EXTREME LOFTING

Out of respect for our host centers and to prevent damage to the lanes, lofting the ball past the arrows is not allowed. A warning will be issued on the first occurrence. If additional infractions occur, the bowler will receive zero pinfall for the second infraction, be disqualified, and be removed from competition for the third infraction.

BEHAVIOUR

Competitors, family members, and coaches are expected to always display good sportsmanship and mutual respect throughout the week of Teen Masters activities. Those failing to do so may be immediately excused from further participation.

PUBLICITY RELEASE

By entering Teen Masters, the bowler acknowledges CPS's right to make use of and to permit others to make use of the bowler's name, scores, voice, pictures, photographs, and other likenesses for any purpose in any manner related to the advertising, broadcast, publication, or promotion of Teen Masters and Skill bowling.





DRESS CODE

- During the official Teen Masters competition, bowlers are required to wear official TM Championships jerseys and are restricted from wearing logos or other sponsor identification not provided by TM.
 During match play, competitors must wear 2025 Championship jerseys.
- Boys must wear black slacks. Black denim is not allowed.
- Girls must wear black slacks, a black skirt, or black dress shorts.
 Black denim is not allowed. Skirts and shorts must be of an appropriate length for bowling.
- Corner Pins Standings will be the final authority on what is an appropriate length.
- Girls electing to wear skirts or shorts are advised to have a pair of black slacks readily available.
- Bowlers violating the dress code will not be allowed to compete until they comply and will receive zero for all frames missed due to the violation.

OWNERSHIP

- Teen Masters is a private event owned by Killer 'B' Promotions (KBP) and Licensed to Corner Pin Standings Pty Ltd (CPS). KBP and CPS reserves the right to determine any matters not covered in these rules, including the right to reject any entries.
- SKILL Bowling is a registered trademark of KBP, and CornerPin Standings Pty Ltd.





REFUNDS

Once paid no refunds will be given. Unless tournament is full or tournament cancelled. Should a refund of a players entry fee be required because of an event cancellation or approved refund by the tournament director, the full amount paid will be transferred to the players portal as a credit amount. The player then has two options:

- 1. Use the total credit amount for any other tournament that is using online entries,
- 2. Request a cash-out of the total credit amount less the processing fee. (3%)
