Getting Here

By Air



Qantas operates multiple 35-minute daily flights between Brisbane and Hervey Bay Airport, while Jetstar operates regular flights from both Melbourne and Sydney. Both airlines offer convenient connections from most Australian capital cities. Seair Pacific has daily 40-minute flights between Hervey Bay and Lady Elliot Island on the southern Great Barrier Reef.

By Train



Queensland Rail operates regular daily services from Brisbane, Rockhampton and Cairns stopping at Maryborough West and Howard stations on the Fraser Coast. Hervey Bay tickets include coach transfers.

By Road



The Fraser Coast is a comfortable three-hour drive, 260km north of Queensland's capital city Brisbane, along the Bruce Highway (A1), with a dual carriageway as far as Gympie. Maryborough is just off the main highway, with Hervey Bay a further 30km north-east on the coast.

Greyhound and Premier coach lines operate several north and southbound services each day to Maryborough and Hervey Bay. Greyhound also offers daily services to the Sunshine Coast via Rainbow Beach. Along with Greyhound, private shuttle transfers operate between the Fraser Coast, Brisbane Airport (domestic and international), Brisbane CBD and Sunshine Coast Airport.

TOURNAMENT RULES

- Entrants must be **2026** registered members of Tenpin Bowling Australia.
- This tournament is conducted under the rules of TBA.
- Check in times will be strictly followed and failure to check in will result in disqualification and the next available reserve in order taking that spot.
- Players are not permitted to smoke or consume alcohol whilst competing.
- Players not registered for the Qtour will pay a \$25 surcharge per event.
- Ties in placings will be decided by a knockout (E.G. Tennis formats will be decided by tournament average).
- Any matters not covered under these rules will be decided by the tournament director and that decision shall be final.
- **DRESS CODE:** Neat tidy acceptable bowling attire is required. No denim, singlets, yoga pants or track suite pants allowed. Tournament directors decision shall be final.
- Once paid no refunds will be given. Unless tournament is full and at the discretion of the tournament director.
- Ladies competing will be off a +8 pins game bonus system.
- Nominations shall be received via Tenpinresults website only.

PLEASE NOTE: This tournament will have handicap rankings points attached to it. All bowlers in the handicap rankings system will automatically have a handicap of 100% of 300 added to their qualifying scores based on their highest league average over 24 games on Tenpinresults.com.au as at the download on the Friday before the tournament. This will determine who is allocated ranking points (Ladies will not receive +8 for this portion) Handicap Payout for this event is based on only to those with an entering average under 190 for men and under 185 for ladies irrespective of where they qualify or finish. Based on the 100 % of 300 and averages downloaded equivalent to above.
