# ENTRY FEES & FORMAT

## QUEENSLAND JUNIOR CUP

Entry Fee for Under 18 Queensland Junior Cup (QJC) - **\$260.**

Re-entry fee - **\$130**

This provides you entry into both the Open and Restricted Division of the Queensland Junior Cup.

## QUEENSLAND YOUTH CUP

Entry Fee for Under 21 Queensland Youth Cup (QYC) - **\$260.**

Re-entry - **\$130**

This provides you with entry into the Under 21 Queensland Youth Cup only. Not the QJC.

## QUEENSLAND JUNIOR & YOUTH COMBINED ENTRY

Entry fee for Junior Bowlers into both the QJC & QYC - **\$390.** Re-entry - **\$130**

U18 Bowlers wishing to qualify for the Queensland Youth Cup will need to pay a one-off \$130.00 entry fee.

Squad positions will only be secured by paying the deposit of \$100 for entries and \$130 for re-entries via [www.tenpinresults.com.au](http://www.tenpinresults.com.au)

Balance of entry fee will be required to be paid by 17 April 2026 via [www.tenpinresults.com.au](http://www.tenpinresults.com.au)

## FORMAT

**PLEASE NOTE: QUALIFYING FOR THE 2026 QJC & QYC IS 12 GAMES  
(You will need to nominate into a minimum of 2 squads).**

## QUEENSLAND JUNIOR CUP (U18 OPEN BOYS & GIRLS)

Top 12 Males (U18) and Top 12 Females (U18) on pinfall qualify for Stage 2 of the QJC. The remainder of the U18 field out of the cut will have their handicap added to their qualifying pinfall. The Top 6 bowlers will compete in the Graded Final.

### Stage 2

Top 12 Boys and Top 12 Girls will bowl a further 4 games with pinfall to carry over. At the conclusion of these games, the field will be cut to the Top 6 Boys and Top 6 Girls - who will progress through to Matchplay. Pinfall will carry over.

### Matchplay

Five (5) games of head-to-head round-robin, with 30 bonus pins awarded for a win, 15 bonus pins for a tie. The Boy and Girl with the highest aggregate pinfall after the matchplay round (inc bonus pins), will be declared the 2026 Queensland Junior Cup Champions.

# ENTRY FEES & FORMAT

## RESTRICTED/HANDICAP EVENT

The remainder of the field out of the stage 2 cut line will have their handicap added to their qualifying pin fall. The Top 6 bowlers in the handicap division will proceed to the final on Monday 4th May 2026.

Handicap - 100% of 220\*\*, averages submitted are to be taken from the bowler's highest league average over a minimum of 16 games as at 14 April 2026. Bowlers are to provide a certified average by your Home Centre when checking in to be eligible to enter the Handicap Division.

\*\*The Tournament Director reserves the right to alter the handicap percentage for the Handicap Division to comply with TBA Rules & Regulations.

**Top 6 Boys and Top 6 Girls will contest the head-to-head round robin final. Pinfall will drop from qualifying.**

**Matchplay** - 5 games of head-to-head round robin, with 30 bonus pins for a win and 15 bonus pins for a tie. The Boy and Girl with the highest aggregate pinfall after the matchplay round (inc bonus pins), will be declared the 2026 Queensland Junior Restricted Cup Champions.

**Only bowlers that have provided certified averages on or before check-in will be eligible for the Graded Division.**

## UNDER 21 QUEENSLAND YOUTH CUP

This is a scratch event open to all junior and youth bowlers (male and female). This event will have separate Male and Female Divisions.

Top 12 Males (U21) and Top 12 Females (U21) on pinfall qualify for Stage 2 of the QYC.

### Stage 2

Top 12 Male and Top 12 Female, will bowl a further 4 games with pinfall to carry over. At the conclusion of these games, the field will be cut to the Top 6 Male and Top 6 Females who will progress through to matchplay. Pinfall will carry over.

### Matchplay

5 games head-to-head round robin, with 30 bonus pins for a win, 15 bonus pins for a tie. The Boy and Girl with the highest aggregate pinfall after the matchplay round (inc bonus pins), will be declared the 2026 Queensland Youth Cup Champions.

**Award Ceremony will be conducted at the conclusion of the Finals on Monday, 4 May 2026.**

# RULES & REGULATIONS

## TBA RULES & REGULATIONS WILL APPLY AND ALL BOWLERS MUST ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING:

1. Open to all 2026 TBA registered bowlers under the age of 18 as of 1st January 2026 (QJC) and 2026 TBA Registered bowlers under the age of 21 as of 1st January 2026 (QYC).
2. This is a TBA accredited event and all TBA Rules and Regulations will apply.
3. Check-in by the advertised time.
4. As a Ranked Event, all TBA Ranked Event rules apply. Refer to <https://tenpin.org.au/wp-content/uploads/2026/03/2026-Rankings-Ranked-Event-Policy-020326.pdf> This includes a ball registration process limiting each athlete to a max of 6 bowling balls. These 6 balls must be USBC approved but NOT listed on the USBC Ineligible ball list. 5. The Tournament Director and event staff have the right to check any equipment as they deem necessary.
6. Bowlers are not permitted to smoke or consume alcohol whilst competing in the tournament.
7. Bowlers must wear acceptable attire at all times. No jeans, cords or tracksuit pants are permitted.
8. Unsportsmanlike behaviour will not be tolerated.
9. A deposit of \$100 will be required at the time of entry and balance payable on 17 April 2026.
10. Refund of entries - should a refund of a players entry fee be required because of an event cancellation or approved refund by the Tournament Director, the full amount paid will be transferred to the players portal as a credited amount. The player then has two options 1) Use the total credit amount for any other tournament that is using online entries or 2) Request a Cash-Out of the total credit amount less the processing fee of 3%.
11. Final placings will be determined by overall pinfall. In the event of a tie in 'Qualifying' the highest last game played by participants will decide the who progresses to the next stage. For the 'Finals', any ties require a 1-game playoff. If scores remain tied after this, then a 9th and 10th frame shootout will continue until the tie is broken.
12. If a bowler takes up the re-entry offer, the two (2) highest 6-block scores will be used to determine their placing.
13. The Tournament Director will have the final say and decide any matter not covered in these conditions.
