# FORMAT

## QUALIFYING

ALL BOWLERS WILL BOWL TEN (10) QUALIFYING GAMES IN ONE (1) SQUAD APPEARANCE. QUALIFYING WILL BE CONDUCTED ACROSS THREE (3) SQUADS, WITH A MAXIMUM OF TWENTY-FOUR (24) BOWLERS PER SQUAD.

## MATCHPLAY FINALS

AT THE CONCLUSION OF QUALIFYING, THE TOP TWELVE (12) BOYS AND TOP TWELVE (12) GIRLS, BASED ON TOTAL PINFALL, WILL ADVANCE TO THE FINALS.

QUALIFYING PINFALL WILL CARRY FORWARD INTO THE FINALS.

FINALISTS WILL BOWL ELEVEN (11) GAMES OF MATCH PLAY.

BONUS PINS WILL BE AWARDED AT THE CONCLUSION OF EACH MATCH AS FOLLOWS:

- WIN - THIRTY (30) BONUS PINS
- TIE - FIFTEEN (15) BONUS PINS
- LOSS - ZERO (0) BONUS PINS

## STEPLADDER FINALS

AT THE CONCLUSION OF MATCH PLAY, THE TOP THREE (3) BOYS AND TOP THREE (3) GIRLS, BASED ON TOTAL PINFALL PLUS BONUS PINS, WILL ADVANCE TO THE STEPLADDER FINALS.

THE STEPLADDER FINALS WILL CONSIST OF THIRD PLACE VERSUS SECOND PLACE, WITH THE WINNER ADVANCING TO FACE THE TOP QUALIFIER FOR THE TITLE MATCH.

THE WINNERS OF THE TITLE MATCHES WILL BE DECLARED THE 2026 JUNIOR SYDNEY CUP BOYS CHAMPION AND THE 2026 JUNIOR SYDNEY CUP GIRLS CHAMPION.

# BONUS PRIZES

Thanks to the generous support of Sunset Bowling Supplies, BPD Australia, and Shoe Fresh, additional prizes will be awarded during the 2026 Junior Sydney Cup.

**BDP Australia** will provide a bowling ball to be awarded to the highest-finishing non-cashing Under 15 Boy and highest-finishing non-cashing Under 15 Girl.

In addition, **Sunset Bowling Supplies** will provide bowling balls to winners of the Best and Fairest Award which will be presented to one boy and one girl who exemplify the values of sportsmanship, respect, and positive conduct throughout the tournament.

Finally, **Shoe Fresh** has generously sponsored the event by providing \$50 prizes for both the highest boys' game and highest girls' game in games 2, 4, 6, 8 and 10 across the combined qualifying squads. This means there will be a total of 10 x \$50 prizes (5 Boys & 5 girls) awarded at completion of qualifying.



# RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Open to all 2026 TBA registered bowlers under the age of 18 as of 1st January 2026
2. This is a TBA-accredited event and all TBA Rules & Regulations will apply
3. As a TBA Nationally Ranked Event, the current TBA National Ranked Event Policy applies. This includes mandatory bowling ball registration, compliance with the IBF 78D urethane hardness regulation, and a maximum limit of six (6) bowling balls per participant.
4. One entry per bowler only
5. Any ties after the 10 games will be decided by the highest 10th game of qualifying. If this score is still tied, the 9th game will be used and subsequent games until a tie is broken.
6. Bowlers must wear acceptable attire at all times. No jeans, cords or tracksuit pants are permitted
7. Unsportsmanlike behaviour will not be tolerated
8. A deposit of \$100 will be required at the time of entry and balance payable on 9 July 2026.
9. Ranking points will only be allocated to all eligible TBA registered bowlers.
10. Refund of entries – should a refund of a player's entry fee be required because of an event cancellation or approved refund by the tournament director, the full amount paid will be transferred to the player's portal as a credited amount. The player then has two options  
1) Use the total credit amount for any other tournament that is using online entries or  
2) Request a Cash-out of the total credit amount less the processing fee of 3%
11. The Tournament Director will decide any matter not covered in these conditions
