HANDICAP SYSTEM

Handicap is based on 90% of a 240 average.

Handicap per game = $(240 - \text{Bowler average}) \times 90\%$

All Silver Challenge Final Bowlers receive handicap

SILVER CHALLENGE FINAL DETAILS

- Round 1 – Top 8
- Bowl 2 games, Top 4 advance

- Round 2 – Top 4
- Bowl 2 games, Players are seeded based on these 2 games

Any ties in the Silver Challenge Final will be decided by Highest Last Game.

PRIZE FUND

The top 8 Bowlers (by handicap) who do NOT qualify for the Youth Final, will compete in the Silver Challenge Final.

TOURNAMENT STRUCTURE

QUALIFYING DETAILS

- All bowlers bowl 2 Squads (12 games).
- Combined pinfall from both squads determines qualifying position.
- Top 10 Male and top 10 Female scratch qualify for the NSW Youth Cup Final in their respective division
- Tie-Breaker Rule: In the event of a tie, the highest single game score bowled across all 12 games will be used to determine the placing.

YOUTH FINAL DETAILS

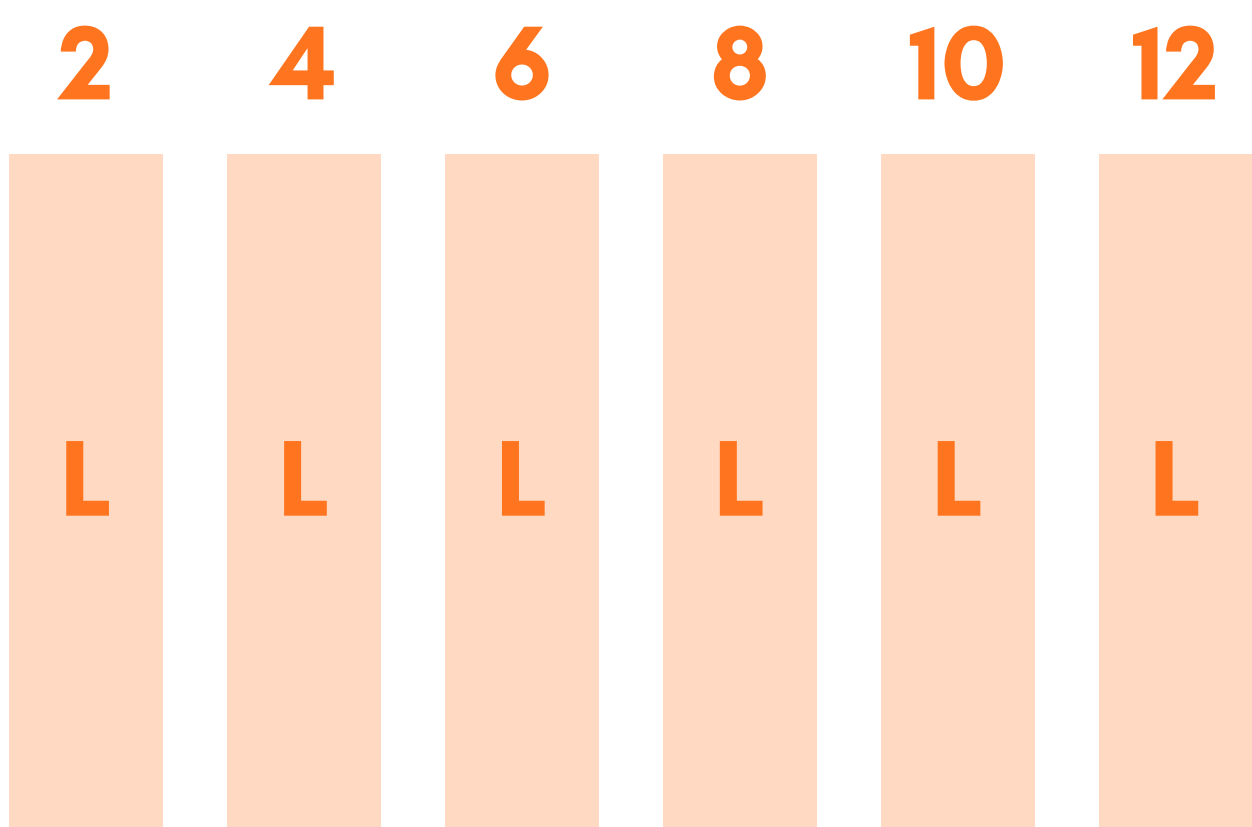
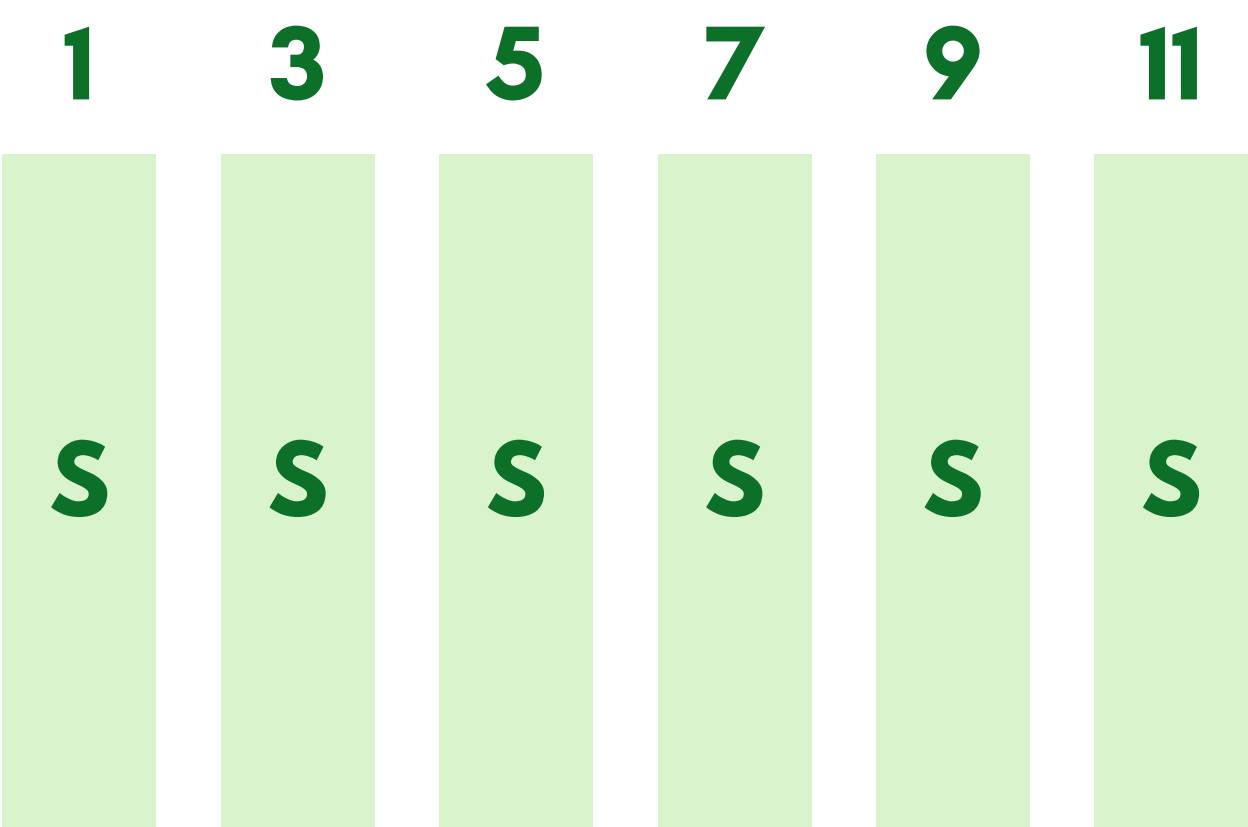
- Bowlers compete on dual pattern lanes (Odd = Short, Even = Long)
- Match Play format - Win = +30 pins, Tie = +15 pins, Loss = 0 pins
- Matchplay games (pinfall + bonus pins) + Qualifying total pinfall wins the title (Qualifying pinfall carries over to final)
- No stepladder final
- Tie-Breaker Rule: In the event of a tie, the highest game score bowled without bonus pins will be used to determine the placing.

LANE CONDITIONS - FINALS

This is a dual pattern event. During Finals, lanes are set as:

Odd Lanes = Short pattern

Odd Lanes = Short pattern



Every Pair is a dual pattern pair. Bowlers will move pairs after each game

RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

PROTEST: Only competing players directly involved with this event may lodge a protest or results enquiry in relation to this event. This must be lodged in writing and signed to the tournament team within sixty (60) minutes of the completion of the final frame of the tournament. After this time, the results will be considered final and no further correspondence will be addressed by the tournament team.

TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR: The tournament director has the right to change anything at anytime before and/or during the event.

DRESS CODE: All bowlers are requested to wear a collared shirt or bowling industry manufactured shirt. Males may wear long pants (Shorts not permitted). Females may wear shorts, 3/4 pants or skorts. No denim jeans, cargo pants, tracksuit pants, T shirts, tank tops, or hats are to be worn whilst competing unless an exemption to the dress rules has been sought from the Tournament Director.

CHECK-IN: Bowlers not checked-in by the advertised time will be disqualified and will have no claim on any prize money.

SCORING ERRORS: Any errors in scoring must be advised to the Tournament Director prior to the Prize Fund presentation. After that time, all positions and payouts will remain as presented.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES: Apart from medical aids, no electronic earpieces, headphones or any other electronic device excluding hearing aids can NOT be worn or used by bowlers whilst they are competing.

HOST CENTRE: Ballina Tenpin Bowl, 16 Clark Street, Ballina, NSW, 2478

RULES: All TBA Tournament Rules and Regulations, including the Code of Ethics shall apply at all times. This includes the 6 ball limit rule.

ELIGIBILITY: The NSW Youth Cup is open to all 2026 TBA members in good standing and all non-resident bowlers who are a member of an affiliated federation who have not reached their 21st birthday on the 1 January 2026.

ENTRY FEE: The entry fee for participation in the NSW Youth Cup is \$270 and a \$100 deposit will be required to reserve your spot on TenpinResults with the balance due 23/10/2026.

NO REFUND AFTER ENTRIES CLOSE: Individuals who do not bowl in their allocated squads will not be entitled to claim a refund. Individuals who are unable to bowl in their event, can sell their spot to another competitor. Whilst the Tournament Committee will help where possible to reschedule entries, it is not the responsibility of the Tournament Committee to sell or recover money for unused entries.

ENTRY PORTAL: Entries will be accepted and processed on the TenpinResults portal.

RANKED EVENT: This event is a nationally ranked event for the TBA Youth Division.

NO BALL RESURFACE: As per TBA Ranked Event policy – no resurface or cleaning allowed during a squad after first ball is bowled. You are allowed to resurface during practice.

SMOKING/DRINKING: No smoking, vaping or drinking of alcohol is permitted whilst a bowler is participating in the event until either the end of the day's play or the bowler is eliminated from the event.
