# Event Format

Qualifying for all divisions will be consist of 6 games.

Re-entries are accepted, if a person's re-entry 6 game score is higher than the original, this will become their final qualifying score.

## Finals

### **Open Event:**

Top 24 bowlers based on their final qualifying score will progress into the finals.

Top 24 will play 4 games total pinfall, the field will then cut to 12.

Top 12 will bowl 11 game head-to-head matchplay. 20 pins for a win, 10 for a draw and 0 for a loss. **Pinfall will drop before match play.**

### **Graded Event:**

Top 16 adult bowlers based on their final qualifying score including handicap will progress into the finals. Please note that pinfall plus handicap carries for the entirety of the graded event from qualifying to the finals.

The Top 16 will play 6 games; where the bowler with the highest pinfall inclusive of handicap will be declared the 2022 Shellharbour Graded Cup Champion.

### **Junior Event:**

Top 8 bowlers based on their final qualifying score including handicap will progress into the finals. Please note that pinfall plus handicap carries for the entirety of the junior event from qualifying to the finals.

The Top 8 will play 6 games; where the bowler with the highest pinfall inclusive of handicap will be declared the 2022 Shellharbour Junior Cup Champion.

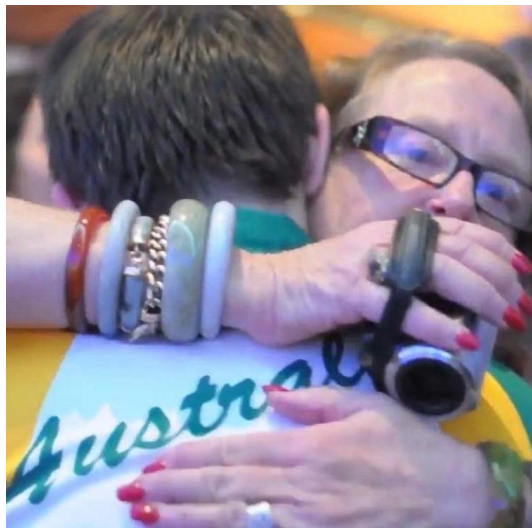

Following on from the first annual event in 2020, the Adult Open Division event will be named the **Donna Cooley Memorial Open**. Donna was a much loved member of the bowling community who sadly lost her long battle with cancer on the 18th February 2020. Donna devoted her life to her son and bowling. For the past 20 years she was a permanent fixture in bowling centres around the country and the world. We would love to continue to honour her and her wonderful life every year going forward. Sam and Shellharbour Tenpin Bowl would like to invite members of the bowling community to compete in this event in her memory.

## Tournament Conditions

- This is a TBA accredited event and all TBA Rules & Regulations apply. All participants must be a current TBA member.
- The adult graded and junior divisions are handicapped, that being 100% of 200 (or 100% of 10 pins over the highest junior entering average, whichever is highest). The highest league average (from Tenpin Results) as of 31/03/2022 where 21 or more games have been bowled must be used. The open division is a scratch event exclusive of 8 pins to be allocated to a female entrant each game throughout the event.
- Junior is defined as a bowler who has not reached the age of 18 years on the 1<sup>st</sup> of January 2022. An adult bowler with an average equal or below 189 as of 31/03/2022 will be eligible for the graded division.
- Prize funds will be adjusted to reflect entries on the day.
- All bowlers must wear a bowling or collared shirt. Male bowlers are required to wear tailored slacks or tailored shorts. Female bowlers may wear skirts, tailored slacks or tailored 3/4 shorts or skorts.
- A tie for 1st place in any masters event will be broken by a 1 game roll off, if still tied then will go to a 10th frame roll off until the tie is broken. A tie for a final qualifying position will be broken by the highest last game. Should any bowler tie for a finals position, prize fund will be combined and then divided evenly.
- All bowlers must check in to the bowling counter by the advertised times, check in closes for all squads 10 minutes prior to the advertised start time.
- TBA's no smoking rule will apply; smoking is prohibited from the first ball of warm up until the announcement of event conclusion due to it being a multi-day event.
- Any protests must be lodged with the tournament committee within 15 minutes of the completion of bowling in which the incident occurred. Any matter not covered in these conditions will be decided by the tournament committee.
- The tournament director will have the right to regrade any bowler's average where deemed necessary.
- Nominations will be accepted via the Tenpin Results. A non-refundable deposit of \$80 per squad must be paid to secure your entry.
- Kicking, punching or hitting of any equipment within the surroundings of the property will not be tolerated this includes but is not limited to ball returns, foul lights, key pads, lounges, tables and chairs. This will lead to disqualification and the forgoing of any prize fund owing to the person.
- This tournament will be running in accordance with all COVID-19 restrictions. There is strictly no contact including but not limited to high fiving and hand shakes.
- By entering this event, you hereby understand and agree to all the above conditions.
